

# Placement Testing

## ***English Composition-***

Placement decisions for English Composition are based on Critical Reading and Writing scores (or the Verbal score) from the SAT. No additional placement testing is required for English Composition.

## ***Mathematics-***

Placement in mathematics courses is based on a placement test administered by Pitt-Greensburg's Math Department. Most students take this placement test during their Summer Orientation and Academic Registration session in the summer. **Only those students applying for an Academic Learning Community may take the math placement test before Summer Orientation.**

First-year students who apply for an Academic Learning Community, must take the math placement test early (the earlier the better!) to get an early placement decision. The math placement test is offered through Pitt-Greensburg's External Studies Testing service **between May 26 and July 22, 2009 (except July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2009)**. Summer hours for External Studies testing are given below. You do not need to pre-register for these exams, simply show up at the assigned location during one of the days and times listed. **First-Year Students who want to take an early math placement test must have already applied for an Academic Learning Community or must bring their application with them at the time of testing!** A valid photo ID must also be presented.
