Students complete six courses (18 credits): two core courses and four other elective classes from the list below. The electives are divided into "R" (digital research) and "P" (project presentation) courses, and students must take at least one of each kind. Some courses can satisfy either requirement but cannot satisfy both simultaneously. The two other courses may be any from the list below, or another course subject to approval by the faculty committee supervising Digital Studies.
